### Helped the revamp of High Plains Library District's Summer Reading Adventure to:

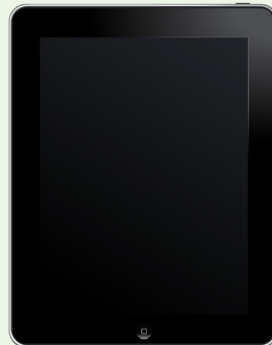
Increase registration 20% from 2013 to 8,272 total registrants.
